## igor zavatckii trio

Igor Zavatckii studied piano in St Petersburg. He completed his master's degree in jazz at the Folkwang University of the Arts in Essen. He was the winner of the Steinway Prize in 2015. With his virtuoso, free expression, his piano playing creates a magical sound that epitomises his independence and at the same time creates the ideal synergy in his interplay with the trio.

Giacomo Tagliavia is a Sicilian bassist and composer from Berlin, Germany, a graduate of the City College of New York and currently pursuing a Master's degree at the prestigious Global Jazz Institute at Berklee. Giacomo's primary influences and inspiration come from jazz and classical music, but he performs in a variety of contexts and a wide range of genres, including rock, RnB, electronic and Afrobeat. Giacomo was included in the 2014 Italian Dictionary of Jazz, written by music journalist Flavio Caprera.

Sławek Dudar is a polish saxophonist, currently living in Germany, a graduate of the Jazz Department of the Academy of Music in Wrocław and a saxophone teacher at the School of Music - Symphony Orchestra in Hof, Germany, artistic director of the Festival - Hof Jazz Nights in Hof an der Saale, and he is a sideman composer and leader of the bands Sławek Dudar Quartet, Blue Couch, Trylobity, and many others.
